Quilt Your Own Quilt on a Long Arm Quilting Machine

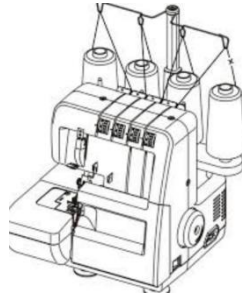
